LEADERSHIP & WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT ASSESSMENT

The Federal Supervisor Assessment (FSA) provides government agencies a powerful online tool for selecting the best applicants for supervisor positions. The FSA is administered through OPM's USA Hire online assessment program and is composed of two question types:

- **Situational Judgment**: Applicants are presented realistic work problems or scenarios common to supervisory positions in the Government and asked to evaluate effectiveness of responses.
- Biodata: Applicants are presented questions about their personal experiences and work-styles as they relate to supervisor positions in the Government.

FSA questions target seven critical supervisory competencies: Accountability, Customer Service, Decisiveness, Flexibility, Interpersonal Skills, Problem Solving, and Resilience.

- Competencies assessed by the FSA can complement information obtained in online assessment questionnaires and structured interviews
- Candidates complete the FSA at the time of application
- Results help identify the top candidates to move forward in the selection process
- FSA can be quickly implemented and is fully compatible with USA Staffing
